Will I need to register or pay for additional meals or events surrounding the CCS?

All meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) will be included with registration.

All agenda activities and events are included with registration.

What is the cost to attend the 2026 CCS?

Early bird registration for the full conference opens November 7 at a rate of \$500, which includes access to all sessions and meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner). Please note that hotel accommodations are not included in the registration fee. A special CCS 2026 group rate is available at the Marriott Phoenix Resort Tempe at The Buttes for \$195 per night, plus a \$15 destination fee and 14.07% tax. Daily parking is \$20 for stays under six hours.

Can I use Clinisys™ iMentor credits to attend?

Yes, the CCS planning team will send a dedicated communication in November to Clinisys™ iMentor customers who have available flex credits.

Please note: Any unused Clinisys iMentor flex credits set to expire may be applied to CCS 2026, provided registration is completed before the credit expiration date. This ensures customers can maximize the value of their credits while securing their spot at the event.

When will an agenda and session details be available?

CCS registration opens in November. A limited agenda and an employer justification letter are already available on the event website. The full agenda, including session details, will be published by December 1. Attendees will be able to bookmark sessions of interest starting two weeks before the event, once room assignments and times are posted.
